**OUR PRIMARY GOAL**

We seek to educate people about the various dimensions of the relationships between humans and animals.

We hope that this will result in happier lives for both and in a decrease in the number of animals that are surrendered by guardians, as well as in the number of animals being killed.

**OUR SECONDARY GOAL**

We engage in whatever advocacy activities are necessary to provide animals with a high quality of life, starting with rescue, boarding, finding human partners for them, and establishing lines of communication with these human partners to guarantee the well-being of animals.

**TYPES OF MEMBERSHIP**

**SUPPORTING MEMBERS:** People who show their commitment to the goals of PG&AAS by financially supporting their implementation, promoting them within the community, and sharing their recommendations.

**PARTICIPATING MEMBERS:** People who in addition to the above also volunteer and contribute their time and effort toward the implementation of the goals by participating in the activities designed to reach those goals.

**BENEFITS OF MEMBERSHIP**

Members attend weekly meetings at which (a) they can learn the information and develop the skills to enhance their relationships with their animals; (b) have an opportunity to socialize with other members and create networks of helpful resources; and (c) stay informed about the activities and projects of the corporation. Members are entitled to attend the public meetings of the Board of Directors and participate in the deliberations. Members are entitled to vote in the yearly election of Board members.

**TASKS THAT MEMBERS CAN PERFORM**

Assist pet owners as they struggle to keep an animal rather than abandoning it; help rescue animals prior to their being abandoned; foster animals that have been abandoned; help prepare animals and prospective adopters for a mutually satisfying relationship; help children gain a better understanding and appreciation of sharing their lives with animals; participate in the Animals for Seniors project; participate in the Trap-Neuter-Return projects; offer support in hospice programs for aged and sick animals; contribute their special expertise to the many administrative activities.
